4	<p>Introduction to Natural Medicine</p> <p>In this course, students are introduced to the philosophy of natural medicine and the concepts of Rongoā Māori and herbal medicine in a New Zealand context. Concepts of holistic health, well-being, a healthy lifestyle and prevention of disease will be introduced. The principles and goals of Herbal Medicine will be explored. A range of herbs and their traditional and modern applications will be studied.</p>	15
4	<p>Introduction to Biological Sciences</p> <p>In this course, students are introduced to the essential concepts of the biological sciences. General principles of chemistry, biochemistry, microbiology, anatomy and physiology and nutrition, will be explored with reference to the normal healthy human body.</p>	15
4	<p>Academic Learning Skills</p> <p>In this course, students will develop study skills, academic writing, reasoning and effective communication. Students will develop an understanding of academic integrity.</p>	15
4	<p>Computing & Digital Skills</p> <p>In this course, students will develop skills in information and digital technology in an academic context.</p>	15

NZ Certificate in Study & Career Preparation Level 4

This programme is aimed at developing the skills, knowledge and attributes for further education in natural medicine at Bachelor's degree level. It will provide an alternative pathway into the Bachelor of Natural Medicine.

As a NZCertSCP (L4) student you will:

- Gain the confidence and skills for tertiary study
- Be prepared for SPCNM Bachelor of Natural Medicine
- Be eligible to pathway into our Bachelor of Natural Medicine degree upon successful completion of the certificate.

Programme Overview

The NZCertSCP (L4) comprises of four 15 credit courses as follows:

- Introduction to Natural Medicine
- Introduction to Biological Sciences
- Academic Learning Skills
- Computing and Digital Skills

Programme Length

20 Weeks (including holiday weeks)

Tuition Fees

Domestic: \$2280 for 60 credit programme

International: \$10,600

Entry Requirements

To be admitted to this programme, applicants must meet the requirements set out below:

DOMESTIC STUDENTS:

- NCEA Level 2 (or equivalent)

OR

- A Level 3 industry-specific qualification

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:

Where English is a second language, applicants must meet the Academic IELTS, overall band standard of 5.5 (with no individual band with a score less than 5.0) or equivalent before enrolment.
