Bachelor of Natural Medicine fee per year - Years 1, 2 & 3 (includes GST for students based in NZ)	\$18,000
NZ Cert in Study & Career Preparation (L4) (includes GST for students based in NZ) NB: Only available on-line, although International Students based in NZ must study at our Ellerslie site.	\$10,600
Compulsory Student Services fee (\$25 per course + GST for students based in NZ)	\$25.00 or \$28.75 per course

Fees Conditions:

- The cost of course tuition is met by tuition fees and government funding
- As required, fees paid are held in a Trust Fund
- No student shall graduate unless all fees and other costs have been paid in full
- Course fees do not include textbooks and course related materials or equipment. Students should allow approximately \$1200 per year (full-time) for books and other course related expenses.
- Students who change their mode of learning for a course from on-line to on-campus, or vice versa, will be charged a \$50.00 administration fee per course.

Student Loans & Allowances – for Domestic Students only

SPCNM's programmes are NZQA approved therefore students are eligible for Student Loans through Studylink.

Note:

To be eligible for a Student Allowance or Student Loan you must be a New Zealand citizen. If not a New Zealand citizen, you must be an ordinarily resident in New Zealand and meet one of the following residence requirements: have been entitled to reside indefinitely in New Zealand under the Immigration Act 2009 for at least 3 years and have been living in New Zealand for at least 3 years or be a refugee or protected person and be entitled to reside indefinitely in New Zealand under the Immigration Act 2009 or sponsored into New Zealand by a family member who holds refugee status or protected person status.
